1. ARMIDALE MEETING OF A.W.F.S...Sat. 20/11/99 and Sun. 21/11/99.

I have booked the Function Room at the **ARMIDALE BOWLING CLUB** for Saturday 20th November 1999. The Bowling club is very centrally located in Dumaresq St. near the centre of town and would be within walking distance of most of the city's accomodation. We can take possession of the room at 9.30 am and use it all that day and evening. I have'nt finalised all aspects of the program yet but the main features will be as shown below..

Please note that the Function Room is on the 1st floor which means going up a flight of stairs..The club is planning to install a lift but it is not there yet..Wheelchair access will thus necessitate a manual lift, but I'm sure our Society will have enough able-bodied members there, to provide the muscle if needed.

From a previous questionnaire I estimate that between 50 and 70 members and guests will be attending, but as I have to give the caterers a firm number before the event, it would be appreciated if **ACCEPTANCES** are returned to me (with payment) as soon as possible..Once the money is paid I can be fairly confident that it will be followed up by an attendance..

Please note that any guests you wish to bring will be welcome...whether Society Members or not.

SATURDAY 20th November 1999..

9.30am...Registrations (Function Room)

10.30am - 6.30pm....Informal (or formal) discussions..socialising etc..(Function Room)

Lunch is a "make you own arrangements" affair...the club has a very good restaurant/bistro and will provide lunch for those who wish to stay there..

6.30pm - 7.00pm....Pre Dinner drinks with hot and cold savories...(Function Room)

The savories are included in the dinner price, but drinks will need to be purchased by members from a bar in the function room...soft drinks will be available, and new beer will be "on tap" along with a limited selection of bottled wines etc..The main club bar on the ground floor can be used by our members if the drinks wanted are not available from the Funtion Room bar..Prices for drinks are very reasonable.

7.00pm - 9.00pm....Society Dinner....Similar to the Tenterfield and Port Macquarie Reunion Dinners....Choice of roast lamb or roast chicken (the caterer serves out 50% lamb and 50% chicken and if you prefer one dish more than the other..swap with someone preferring the opposite to yourself).

If you would like a vegetarian meal instead of one of the above..please let me know when you send in your acceptance, and I will arrange for the club to prepare one for you..

The sweets dishes will be served out in a similar "tandem" fashion..

I was told of Jean's loss to us all, by her son Ken in a letter reproduced below...Quote..

"Dear Ron,

I must apologise for not having written to you sooner.

Sadly I write to tell of my dear Mother's passing on June 4, after a brief illness.

Earlier in the year Mum had apparently been feeling uncomfortable and had finally taken the matter up with her doctor at about the time of her last letter to you. She received the final diagnosis of cancer of the pancreas and liver just after Anzac day..

Mum was able to spend her last 5 days at home , although the last few weeks were a great strain. Her illness was mercifully brief and we must be thankful for that.

She often spoke of you , and of your visit to her at Kandy Avenue , and clearly enjoyed the correspondence and contact that you shared,

Mum's lifelong interest in family matters , geneology, and the accuracy of her research and verification were of great importance to her.

Please feel free to publish any of her writings, I know full well that she would have wanted to help and assist in any way she could. I would ask that I be allowed a copy of anything that you do publish , as I will keep these to-gether with Mum's records and papers for our future generations.

When things have settled down a little I'll make a point of carefully gathering to-gether all of her material for this purpose.

Please also let me know what membership dues there are , as I would like to join up as a means of staying in contact. I cannot hope to be the correspondent that Mum was, but would like to stay in touch nonetheless.

In the meantime I trust that this finds you on the way to recovery from the boatbuilding side-effects mentioned in yours of July 8th to Mum.

Again ,please forgive my not having written earlier to let you know about Mum; things have been rather busy these past few weeks since she passed away.


I was told of Kath's passing by her brother **Bert WAUGH** of Armidale who wrote..inter alia..
