This section was originally nineteen A3 sheets they represent a detailed record (a treasure) of Waugh Family history.

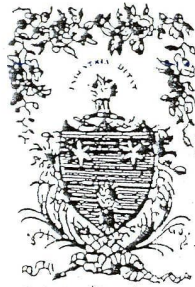
The work and effort over a long period is obvious.

The sheets were produced by **Ruth Waugh** (the great grand daughter of Alexander Waugh DD 1754-1827) in 1916.

The notes were added to by **Edith Mary (May) White**, the great granddaughter of William (the one we have referred to as “Wealthy William”) 1788–1866 and Ann's Harvey. May White was 104 in 1996.

Take your time and study them (they do take an effort) but they are decipherable. The starting point is to work out your relationship to Thomas Waugh 1706 and then you can try to follow the relationship of others in the sheets or their descendants you may know.

This Family Tree was made by Ruth Waugh great grand-daughter of Dr Alexander Waugh. It was finished about 1916. Additions have been made from time to time by E.M. White from information received from relations in England & Australia.

Dr Alexander Waugh, D.D. 1754-1827 was born at East Gordon. He was at village school 1766, then at school at Barlaston. In 1770 he entered the University of Edinburgh. In 1777 he went to the University of Aberdeen. Degree, M.A. 1778. Minister of Newburgh, St. Peter's, till 1782, when he became minister of the Scots Secession Church in White St London for 46 years. Died in Bunkhill Fields, London 1827. He was one of the founders of the London Missionary Society about 1795. He ordained Dr Moffat, the father-in-law of Livingstone, & was associated with Kellie & Co in many philanthropic works. (See Memoir of the Rev. Alexander Waugh) D.D.

He had a business in Surrey St Strand, a counting house & a wharf at the time of Waterloo he was supplying corn to the Army, & was told he would have double pay if he supplied it on Sundays, but he refused saying he would not make profit out of his country's need. About 1808 his nephew William Wrough (1785-1866) entered the business, & about 1828 William's son James. In 1847 William Neill, John's brother left Surrey St (Information from William Neill's diary now in the possession of the Atcham Family, c.1840-1860) - then he & Wrough Messrs Neill & Wrough was the firm that formed the first Corn Exchange in London. more than 100 years after, the Woolner children found a grain of corn in the pocket of John Neill's unlined waistcoat which they had been given to dress up in. Many members of the family possess pieces of the "J.N" initial china, silver etc. John Neill is reported to have left all his nephews £30,000 each. Information from Phyllis Woolner whose grandfather George Wrough of Regent St was one of these nephews.

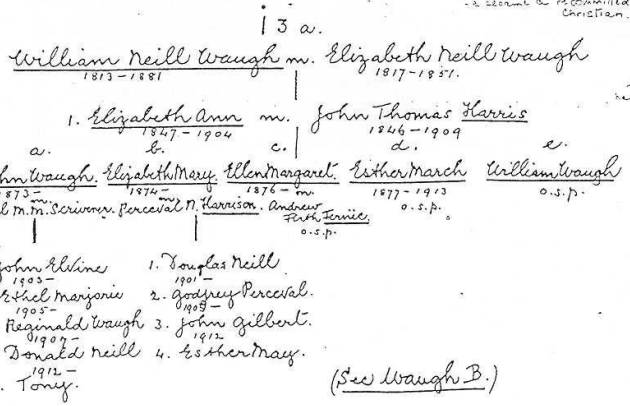
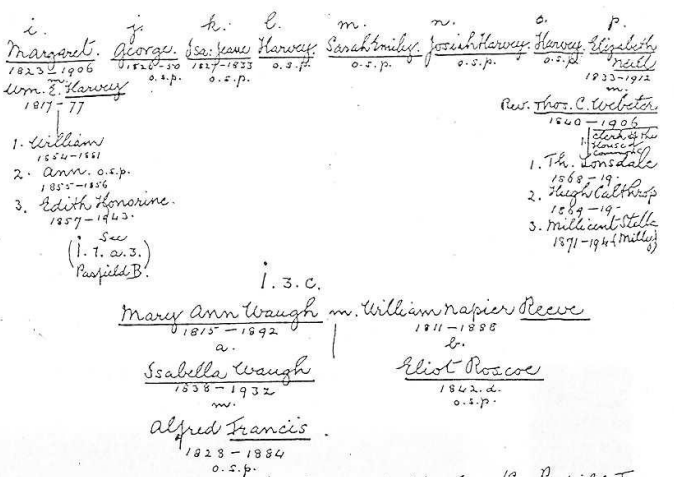
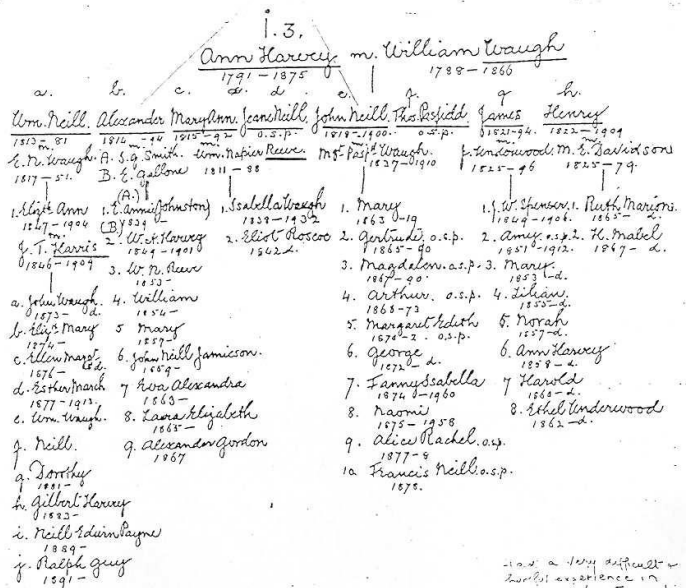
Thomas Pasfield Harvey's date of birth 1788 is taken from his son's Birth Certificate Paris.
In 1824 William + Ann Harvey lived in the Holloway Rd. N. London, in a house where Holloway Passmore's bank next but one to Lorraine Terrace. To this house, to his English Grandparents, William Harvey (2) Harvey aged seven was sent from France in 1824, to be educated at Mill Hill School to which he went in 1829. He came from a convent at Fontainebleau, where he lived with his mother after his father's death. As a little child he was brought up as Roman Catholic.

Ann + William Waugh lived at 37 Essex St. Strand, & later at Old Thirage House, Starnsey.
William Waugh was chairman of the London Loan & Exchange Company and at one ceremony was named in the City. He entertained the Prince Consort. When he retired his fellow members of the committee of the London Loan & Exchange gave him a silver salver which he returned to them as a subject on his death. The committee members gave the salver to his brother George and some James and Henry with a copy of a resolution marking his valuable services and stating personal qualities.

The Harveys came from Aberdeen. William Harvey 1757-1832 was an Elder at St. Alexander Waugh's Independent Presbyterian Church Wells St of Regent St London.
Extracts from William Napier Brewster's Diary. (1811-1885)
"In 1804 William Harvey took over the Grand Junction Wharf in partnership with Thomas Napier. Harvey Napier & Co. They had both married sisters, Ann + Sarah Pasfield. Thomas Napier lived at the Grand Junction Wharf, till 1824, when he moved to a handsome house in Bricklayers Square - five years before he went to Waltham, Essex, where he died + was buried in Broomfield Church. They had both been Doctors previously. In 1824 when Thomas Napier left the wharf, he gave up the house to William's son Josiah Harvey."
Extracts 1854 Margaret (Harvey) nee Waugh) at the Wicary (William Harvey's) 1878. Adith Harvey was married to Mr. Brewster (William Harvey's) and children.

William Napier Reeve was born in 1811 at Boobing Tree (See Pasfield T. for notes on the Reeve Family). He later became a J.P. & Clerk of the Peace for the County of Gloucestershire, Election Agent to Lord John Manners, & Vice President of the Literary & Philosophical Society - also served the office of Under Sheriff. He was a Solicitor by profession, a Member of the Inn of Chancery, Reeve, Alumni & Bachelors by Gloucester City where he lived & celebrated his Golden Wedding the year before he died. He wrote a very interesting diary, now in the possession of his nearest relatives, the Ashursts of Adelaide - also "Conversations on the Path" & numerous poems & articles. He was related to his wife through the Pasfields. His daughter Isabella was closely related to her extreme old age she went to live with her cousin Ellet Honors in Paris. (See Waugh B.)
